All **BRAIN** or **SKULL** injuries

FACE

Significantly Displaced,
Open, Compound or Comminuted #'s
All Lefort #
All Panfacial #
All Orbital blowout #

UPPER LIMB/ LOWER LEG

(inc Clavicle & Scapula but
excluding Hand and Foot)
Any Open Injury
Any 2 Limb #'s or Dislocation

FOOT OR HAND

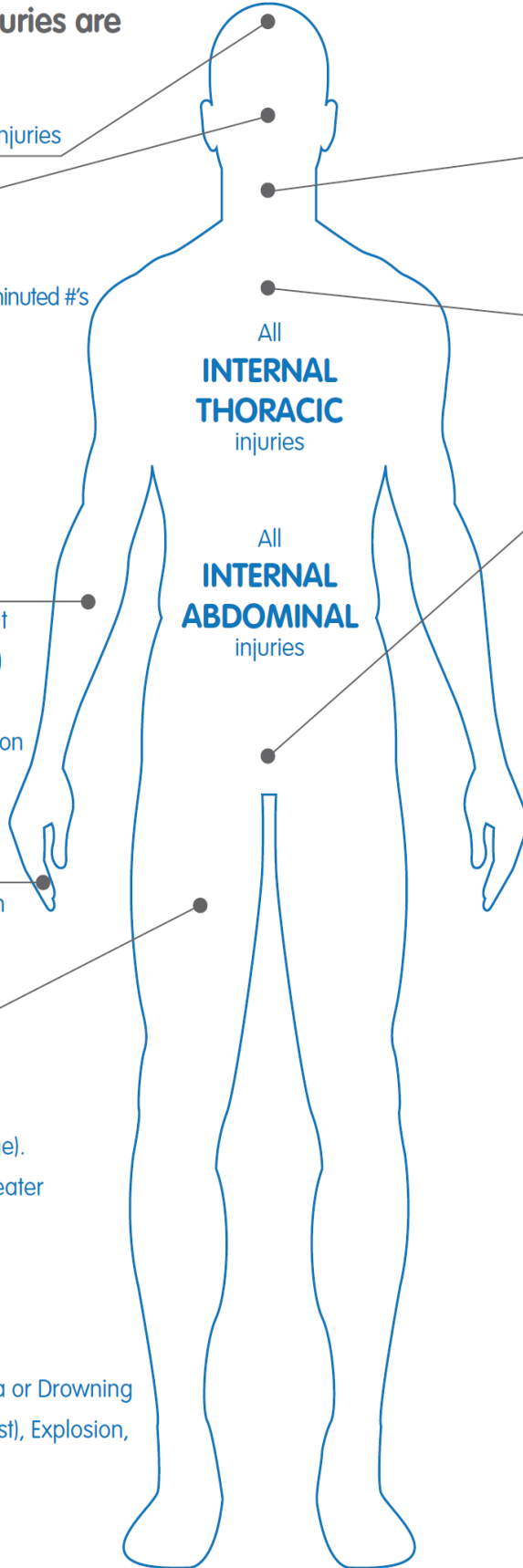
Total Crush or Amputation

FEMUR

All Shaft, Distal, Head or
Subtrochanteric # (any age).
Isolated #NOF or inter/greater
Trochanteric <65 yrs.

ALL

Severe Frostbite, Asphyxia or Drowning
(with LOC or Cardiac Arrest), Explosion,
Electrical Injury.



NECK

Any Organ, Vascular Injury or
Hyoid #

SPINE

Cord Injury, Fracture,
Dislocation, Nerve Root Injury.

PELVIS RING/ ACETABULUM

Ischium, Sacrum, Coccyx,
Ileum, Acetabulum, Multiple
Pubic Rami # (any age) or
Single Pubic Rami <65 years.

VESSEL

All injuries to Femoral, Neck,
Facial, Cranial, Thoracic, or
Abdominal Vasculature.

SKIN

Laceration/Penetrating Injury
with Blood Loss >20% / 1000mls.
Major Degloving.

NERVE

Any Injury to Sciatic, Facial,
Femoral or Cranial.

BURNS/ INHALATION

Any full thickness Burn or
Partial/Superficial Burns >10%
TBSA or Inhalation Injury that
is not treated in a Burns unit.
